Hello JWUMC Family,

The entire month of March falls within the season of Lent this year. That means that our colors will remain purple on the altar at the front of the sanctuary, and our spiritual posture will remain that of reflection and repentance.

Two devotionals were sent out electronically on Ash Wednesday via email, and are available in print in our narthex for the season of Lent.

The first is called *Bless the Lent we Actually Have* by Kate Bowler, and is a daily devotion. It dives deep into the harder and darker parts of our faith journeys. This devotion also makes use of all types of resources; some pages contain QR codes that will take you to a song, a small video clip, or a small podcast clip. If you need assistance in accessing these, please do not hesitate to email or call me. I am glad to assist you in this matter.

The other devotional is called *This Is My Body* by Illustrated Ministry, and is a weekly devotion. It is family friendly. This devotion is the one that is similar to the sermon series we will be following throughout Lent. The stories in it come from Christ's time here on earth, when he had an earthly body like ours. The devotions invite us to consider our whole selves - body and soul - when we think about our faith.

You are welcome to do both devotionals or choose the one that most fits your faith journey at this point. And, if you haven't begun yet, it is okay to start today. My family and I do devotions in the evening and often pull from many different devotionals - based on the need and understanding of each family member.

My hope and prayer is that you are using the season of Lent to grow closer to God. If I can assist you in any way, I would be happy to help.

Apportionment Update

JWUMC sends a little over \$2,100 of the money in our offering plates to the Florida Conference of the United Methodist Church as part of something that we call apportionments. Apportionments are the funds used by the local and global United Methodist Church to do ministry around the world. Each month we will highlight one of the funds our apportionments support. John Wesley has paid 100% of our apportionments since 2015, and we are on track to do so again this year. It is our joy to send these funds each month!

March's Apportionment Highlight: Ministerial Education

John Wesley will contribute \$1,224 toward Ministerial Education this year through our apportionments. This apportionment provides support for the 13 United Methodist seminaries and helps keep tuition costs down. The Ministerial Education fund supports continuing education courses for clergy and diaconal ministers currently serving congregations, as well as courses for training local pastors. The fund sponsors regional and national events where people can explore God's call to ministry. And this money is used to train and support Annual Conference Board of Ordained Ministry members in their work of approving and evaluating leaders who serve the church. UMCOR International Disaster Relief

You have the opportunity through John Wesley Church to give to the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR). Just write a check or place cash in an envelope marked UMCOR IDR/Turkey and put it in the offering plate. Or give online at http://johnwesleyumc.com/donate/ and select "UMCOR" from the drop-down. Consider giving just the amount of a dinner out to support these people in desperate need. UMCOR has released initial solidarity grants to longstanding partner, International Blue Crescent (IBC) and Forum for Development Culture and Dialogue (working in Syria) to help provide tents, heaters, blankets, warm clothes, ready-to-eat meals and first aid kits to those who have been displaced. IBC has offices in Turkey. And know that in Dec. 2022 John Wesley Church sent a \$740 undesignated gift to UMCOR from the Alternative Christmas Market.


